

# **Payroll End of Year**

- ♦ W-2 information is CHECK DATE DRIVEN the date on your paycheck will determine what year the wages are reported to the SSA so be sure to look ahead on your calendar to plan your last PR for the year.
- ◆ There will be a change on W-2's this year on the laser overlay format, so be sure to watch the message board for the latest in procedures and PTF's.
- Even though you do not generate the W-2's until after you have saved off the files after the last PR for 2010, usually these PTF's
  need to be applied previously.
- MN Customers: If you have more than 25 employees you are required to file your W-2's on line this year (next year it is 10 employees, so it is a good time to learn how). There is a separate e-training class for electronic filing.
- Watch for e-trainings on the EOY procedures as an update or review of procedures (next class is Dec. 28th).
- We will have the new Federal Withholding tables (if there are changes) on the Message Board but it is your responsibility for your state tables. If you have questions, fax the information to us and we will help you with them. This also applies to local and school tax information.
- As changes happen, PTF's get updated, so be sure to watch because there may be multiple notifications on the Message Board and the list of PTF's may get updated. Those on the ASP box will have the PTF's automatically applied for them.
- There will also be a <u>checklist for the EOY procedures posted</u>. Be sure if you have to "add" things in PR, like reporting the personal use of company vehicle, that you do that as part of the PR for 2010, before you do a 2011 PR.

#### PLEASE WATCH THE MESSAGE BOARD FOR UPDATED INFORMATION.

#### AP- 1099 Reminders

Here are a few tips for the EOY 1099's for Accounts Payable vendors:

- The limit remains at \$600 so check your constant file to see if it contains that amount.
- Check through your list of vendors to see who is marked to receive 1099's. Be sure you have their Fed. ID or SSN. You can do
  this now.
- REMEMBER, 1099's are determined by the CHECK DATE, not the date you merge or the invoice date so be sure you have all checks printed you want to be part of 1099's.
- When you run your 1099 report, the \$\$ will update the vendor master. If you need to make a correction, you can go to vendor master and put the amount in but then, do not run the report again.
- You can run them on plain paper to verify information and then on the forms.
- We have added the ability to electronically file Misc. 1099's. Check out the e-classes on how to do this time-saving procedure.
- Watch the Message Board for an update on procedures or PTF's that might affect AP.
